Patient Instructions

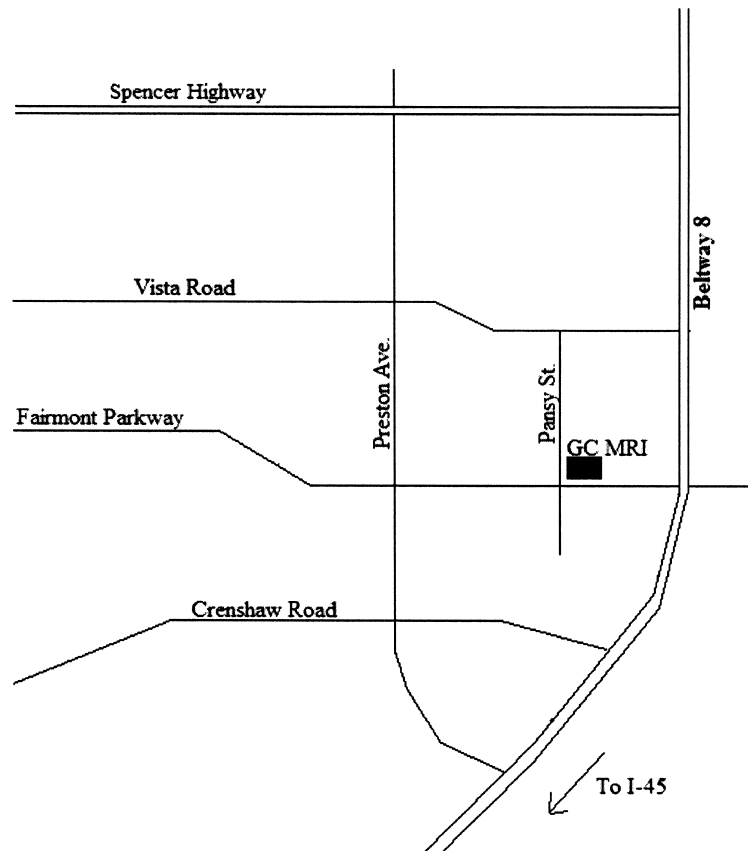
It is very important that you come to the appointment wearing comfortable clothing, as this scan can last between two to three hours, depending on the type of examination being ordered.

Please make sure you arrive on time for your appointment. The radioactive material utilized deteriorates very quickly and the scan must take place **exactly** when scheduled to ensure accuracy.

Do not drink or eat anything except water within six hours of your scheduled appointment. Please drink at least eight glasses of water the day before your scan and two glasses of water the morning of your scan. If your scan is scheduled in the afternoon, please drink several more glasses of water before your scan.

Refrain from performing any strenuous activity for 24 hours before your examination.

Unless ordered otherwise, you may resume your regular diet, but please note that there will still be radioactive material remaining in your body, and you should avoid contact with children or pregnant women for several hours.
